Laminate and Painted Surfaces



To clean, use a damp cloth or sponge and a mild soap detergent.

Rinse thoroughly with warm water and wipe dry.

Difficult stains such as coffee or tea can be removed using a mild household cleaner. The following are recommended household cleaners:

- Windex Multi-surface Disinfectant
- Windex All Purpose Cleaner
- Glass Plus®
- Formula 409®
- Fantastik® (Wilsonart only)
- Mr. Clean® (Wilsonart only)

Acidic or abrasive cleaners can damage laminate or painted surfaces; do not use them. If you spill an abrasive cleaner, wipe it up immediately and rinse several times with water. Avoid use of steel wool and other abrasive pads will cause damage to laminate or painted surfaces. Stubborn stains that resist traditional cleaning methods may require the use of undiluted household bleach. For specific guidelines regarding bleach usage, review the care and maintenance instructions on the Wilsonart (all Simii laminates excluding Clay and Oak) or Panolam (Clay and Oak laminates only) websites.

*Note that prolonged exposure to bleach will cause discoloration

Routine Care for Dust/Dirt Removal

If there is visible dust or dirt embedded in the material, use a bristle brush to loosen it. Avoid excess pressure when using. Vacuum any loose dust and dirt thoroughly from the material.

Routine Care for Spills

To clean any spills. Pat dry as soon as possible to avoid liquids from absorbing into the material. Apply a mild clear detergent or soap and water with a hand spray application. Avoid over-soaking the surface. Allow the surface to air dry.

Routine Care for Stains

To remove any stains; saturate a lint free cloth with a clear, mild detergent or soap and water solution. Gently pat the stain starting from the outer edge and moving inward. If required, get another cleaning cloth and repeat the procedure until there is no more transfer of dirt to the cloth. Once the stain is removed, soak up all remaining cleaning solution with a dry cloth. Use a clean cloth or sponge soaked in water to remove any other residue. Allow the surface to air dry.

Basalto Surfaces



CONCRETE

Applicable for indoor and covered outdoor use. Finished to enhance beauty and improve durability. Protects against penetration of liquids, alcohols, and fats. Clean with a damp cloth using natural detergent. To ensure lasting finish, liquid should be wiped up and not left to sit.

Concrete will patina overtime and should be moved inside during extreme temperature changes. The duration of the finish will depend on the environmental conditions (rain, light and abrasion) to which the product is exposed.

Handmade, natural products will have unique characteristics.

SOLID BLACKSTAINED OAK

For indoor use only. Finished with a formaldehyde free, low toxicity lacquer to seal the porous nature of real wood. Clean with a damp cloth using natural detergent. To ensure lasting finish, liquid should be wiped up and not left to sit. Immediately clean up alcohol or acidic liquids. Not meant for hot objects.

Natural wood will patina overtime. The duration of the finish will depend on the environmental conditions (rain, light and abrasion) to which the product is exposed.
